Meeting minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:11 pm

1) Approval of June 2020 Minutes

3) Finance Report & budget update

Additional information: financial license out. Got operating grant. Few repairs and few more coming (floors - \sim \$1200). As expected. Signed up for pool again at JP. Opening soon. He thought we were paid up until pre-COVID, so he is waiting for an invoice. Have to book times. All being worked through.

Some issues with those financial statements (not submitted) for BS. Sorted out and signed off.

4) Items for discussion

- **Preschool report** Auriana: no one in attendance to report
- Soccer report Perry: as per distributed report. Highlights: most of the participants in U9 and up cancelled. A couple who opted to stay. 30 kids participating in training base program (Rio players grouped with others, not Rio teams). Lost half U7, other half started July 6 (Mon/Wed) for 6 weeks. Perry cutting fields on Sundays. 14 U4/5. 4 teams in U7 19 players. 1st indoor who knows what will happen... so jersey replacement might not be happening this fall. Aug for reg? Do something different with respect to knowing what kind of programming we are offering. Zone

- Hall rental report CA: no one in attendance to report. Was the tennis camp briefed? Sign a new contract? Signs posted? Insurance update?
